

Significant Changes to Cal/OSHA Lockout/Tagout Standards

California Occupational Safety and Health Administration (Cal/OSHA) Standards Board is adopting [significant changes to the state's lockout/tagout \(LO/TO\) standard](#). The changes were initiated due to the differences between Federal OSHA and the Cal/OSHA standards; specifically, in the area addressing group LO/TO requirements. The state's previous LO/TO standard did not specifically address group LO/TO.
