MINUTES OF OPEN SESSION MEETING

FEBRUARY 16, 2012

The Governance Committee met on February 16, 2012 at 333 Bush Street, San Francisco, California.

AGENDA ITEM 1: ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. and the following Members were present: Lawrence E. Mulryan, Chair; Sheryl A. Chalupa; Daniel M. Curtin, Sen. Michael J. Machado (Ret.); and Thomas E. Rankin.

There was a quorum.

AGENDA ITEM 2: APPROVAL OF NOVEMBER 17, 2011 OPEN MEETING MINUTES

To approve the minutes of the November 17, 2011 Open Meeting of the Governance Committee as presented.

Mr. Mulryan requested public comment of which there was none. Mr. Mulryan called for the vote.

AGENDA ITEM 3: RECOMMENDATION ON BOARD TRAINING FOR MARCH 29 & 30, 2012

Valerie Lampson, Learning & Development Manager, presented the recommendation for the Board training on March 29-30, 2012 mandated by Insurance Code Section 11770(e). Ms. Lampson noted that a cost comparison of venues was undertaken and the Fairmont Sonoma was selected because its price was within State Fund's approved per person cost and below the average cost of the other bidders. The attendees will be the Board of Directors, Executive Committee Members, Chief of Internal Affairs and Board Liaison. The training will be done in both open and closed sessions as warranted by content. The National Association of Corporate Directors (NACD), a primary presenter on corporate directorship issues, customized an agenda specific to State Fund

needs, and will be joined by other trainers in this two day session. The completion of training will result in a "Governance Fellow" designation by NACD.

Ms. Lampson also provided information on the upcoming NACD Directorship Spring Forum to be held in New York on June 11-12, 2012 and NACD Board Leadership Conference to be held in Maryland on October 14-16, 2012.

AGENDA ITEM 4: UPDATE ON DILIGENT BOARDBOOK

Hilda Padua, Board Liaison and Assistant Corporate Secretary reported that all Executives, Board Members, Assistant Corporate Secretaries and administrative support staff have been trained to use the Diligent online portal. The Board books for the February 2012 meeting were compiled using this new tool, and members have had access to Diligent Boardbooks on their iPads in the course of the meetings. General Counsel Carol Newman noted the tool provides increased security for transfer of information to the Board Members. Ms. Padua encouraged Board members to continue to provide feedback with the use of the Diligent Boardbooks.

Barbara Simmons, Program Manager of Governance, Compliance and Privacy reviewed the Compliance Framework. All governance reports are grounded in this framework. Ms. Simmons gave an update regarding the Governance Office initiatives, including the Privacy Office launch. State Fund's Privacy Office has developed Information Privacy and Privacy Breach Response protocols and support structure, including notification templates, in order to assure State Fund is informed, prepared and nimble in identifying and responding to any confidential data disclosure. It was also noted that continuing work on updating State Fund guidelines remains on track.
