- The duties and obligations of members of a board of directors
- Corporate Governance
- Ethics
- Board of Director legal issues
- Insurance
- Finance and Investment
- Information Technology

The training shall be conducted by persons or entities not affiliated with the State Compensation Insurance Fund.
